

SUNVITATIONAL TOURNAMENT INFO, FEES: \$80 FOR ALL (CASH/CHECK) DUE ASAP

1. **Friday January 12:** *Friday is for LD & PF ONLY.* Please meet at University School @ NSU by **3:45pm**. You should gather outside of the Epstein Center. (you can be dropped off in the traffic circle by the Lower and Middle Schools). We should be finished Friday by around **9:00pm**, but students will call and give parents ample notice should this time change (they are free to leave at the conclusion of their last round).
2. **Saturday, January 13:** Meet @ University School at NSU at **7:30am**. You should gather outside of the Epstein Center (you can be dropped off in the traffic circle by the Lower and Middle Schools). The entire team will do warm-ups led by your officers from **7:45-8:00am**. We should be finished Saturday by around **8:00pm**, but students will call and give parents ample notice should this time change (they are free to leave at the conclusion of their last round). *Please make sure you pick up your child in a timely manner.*
3. **Sunday, January 14:** Meet @ University School at NSU at **7:15am**. You should gather outside of the Epstein Center (you can be dropped off in the traffic circle by the Lower and Middle Schools). The entire team will do warm-ups with your officers from **7:15-7:30a**. We should be finished Sunday by around **6:30pm**, but students will call and give ample notice should this time change. **NO ONE IS PERMITTED TO LEAVE UNTIL AFTER AWARDS ON SUNDAY (or the FINAL ROUND OF PF/LD).**
4. **IMPORTANT REMINDERS:** This is a NATIONAL tournament. Interpers, you MUST have your cutting with you! Debaters, you MUST have ALL sources with you (or accessible on your computer without accessing the Internet)! Extempers, you MUST get rid of anything that even looks like an outline from your computer! All, you must look like you are at a NATIONAL tournament! ALL STANDARD TEAM TOURNAMENT RULES APPLY!
5. **DRESS CODE.** Please wear approved tournament attire. This means suits for men and women. Shoes must be closed-toe "dress" shoes and socks must be "dress" socks. No tennis shoes, sandals or crocs are allowed at any time. If girls would like to bring flats to wear between rounds they must be appropriate for competition. Hair must also be "fixed" so it is not in a competitor's face (i.e. styled for men and pulled-back partially or fully for women) and no distracting jewelry is allowed.
6. **DIRECTIONS:** Take 595 E to University Ave, south. Follow University Ave to SW 30th Street/Abe Fischler Blvd. Turn left and follow just past the Dolphin Training facility. Turn right at the first entrance onto campus, past the Dolphin headquarters. Follow this side street to the stop sign and pull into the traffic circle. If parking, turn right at the stop sign to park in the Middle School Visitors lot, or left to park in the library parking garage. Please leave extra time to park if you are driving yourself.
